

Rules for Waste Disposal Area B-2

2023

1 Please separate wastes into correct type of garbage bags before disposal.

Please use Kaizuka City's official garbage bags (purple color=burnable garbage and pink color=non-burnable garbage) for non-recyclable waste.

Kaizuka City's official garbage bag can be purchased at stores such as supermarkets and convenience stores.

Please separate recyclables (PET bottles/ Plastics with the recycling mark/ Cans and bottles) into transparent or translucent bags.

2 Please put out waste at the designated collection place.

Please be sure to tie bags well to keep this area clean.

3 Please dispose of waste by 8:45 am on the designated day of the week.

Area B-2 collects garbage every Tuesday and Friday.

Please squeeze out excess water from food waste before disposal.



Please tie bags well to prevent garbage from spilling out.

How to dispose of PET bottles









Items with the PET bottle recycling mark





1) Remove the cap and label.

② Wash with water.

3 Crush

Put in a transparent or translucent bag.

Discard the cap and label with plastic waste.

Separate PET bottles from other plastics with the recycling mark.






Items with the plastic recycling mark

Rinse plastic waste with water before placing it in a transparent or translucent bag.

Throw away dirty items with burnable garbage.



Put in a transparent or translucent bag.

Area B-2 collects garbage on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of each month.

Cans and bottles of food and drink.




Rinse with water and place in a transparent or translucent bag.

Area B-2 collects garbage on the 3ed Wednesday of every month.




Please use up all spray cans and gas cassette cylinders.

Oversized garbage


(large trash that does not fit in the garbage bag)
Please make a reservation by phone.



Measure the size of furniture.


- ① measure the length of A:height, B:width, C:depth of oversized garbage.
- ② for garbage with a total length of A, B and C up to 3 meters, attach one oversized garbage disposal ticket.

For garbage with a total length of A, B and C exceeding 3 meters, attach two oversized garbage disposal tickets.



1 Apply by phone to the Oversized Garbage Reservation Center. 072-429-5374

- 2 The reservation center will inform you of the collection date and discharge location of oversized garbage.
- 3 Purchase oversized garbage disposal tickets at supermarkets, convenience stores, and other stores.
- 4 Attach the oversized garbage disposal ticket to the oversized garbage.
- ⑤ Please take it out to the collection point by 8:45 am on the day of collecting oversized garbage.



How to throw away home appliances.

There is a way to dispose of A B C





Have an electronics store pick up your home appliances.

Have the store (electronics store) where you purchased. There is a charge for picking up.

- Have Ecole (transportation company) pick up home appliances. Home appliance recycling fee and transportation fee will be charged. Ecole Co., Ltd. Ecole can also carry appliances out of the home. 072-458-7557
- Carry it to Nippon Express(pick-up office)by yourself. Please complete the form at the post office to pay for and receive a home appliance recycling ticket (Prices vary by home appliance manufacturer.)



Post Office

Please tell staff the manufacturer name and size of the home appliance to be thrown away to find out the fee amount.

Please enter your name and address on the form and pay the correct fee.

You will receive a recycling ticket for the home appliance.

Take the home appliances to be thrown away and the home appliance recycling ticket (copy) to Nippon Express.




Dry batteries, button batteries, small rechargeable batteries
